Matrix is the test of record for Mercury

Onsite Testing results in <b>Positive</b>	<ul> <li>Matrix or HR Operations calls employee:</li> <li>1. Instructions to self-isolate</li> <li>2. Complete contact tracing interview</li> <li>3. Daily touch-base with employee (by Matrix nurse)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Self-isolate for 10 days</li> <li>Complete contact tracing interview</li> <li>Respond to daily nurse calls</li> <li>Removed from testing pool for 90 days^</li> </ul>
Onsite Testing results in Inconclusive	<ul><li>Matrix calls employee:</li><li>1. Instructions to quarantine</li><li>2. Retest with either At-Home kit or CVS</li></ul>	<ol> <li>Retest as soon as possible</li> <li>Remain at home until Negative results and symptom free</li> </ol>
Onsite Testing results in <b>Negative</b>	Matrix does NOT contact employee	<ul> <li>If not currently in quarantine, employee can return to the workplace</li> <li>Employee can call in for result using locator ID, optional</li> </ul>
Identified as " <b>Close Contact</b> " (e.g., within last 48 hours, within 6' and 15 minutes)	<ul><li>Matrix calls employee:</li><li>1. Instructions to quarantine</li><li>2. Test to shorten duration, with the exception of CA*</li></ul>	<ol> <li>Quarantine for 10 days</li> <li>Test between 5-8 days using either drive-thru or At-Home kit, with the exception of CA*</li> </ol>
<b>Buoy</b> results in "Not Ready for Onsite Work"	<ol> <li>Remain offsite</li> <li>Test to confirm if symptoms are due to COVID</li> </ol>	<ol> <li>Contact manager</li> <li>Get tested as soon as possible with either CVS or at-home kit</li> </ol>
<b>Travel</b> – Before travel using public transportation	<ul> <li>To confirm traveler is COVID negative</li> <li>May require a Negative test to access destination facility (See "Exceptional Access Policy" on following slide)</li> </ul>	1. Complete travel request form: <u>Travel Policy</u>
<b>Travel</b> – Risk of exposure due to public transportation (flight, train, etc.)	<ol> <li>Quarantine for 14 days</li> <li>Test to shorten duration</li> </ol>	<ol> <li>Quarantine for 14 days</li> <li>Test between 5-8 days after exposure event (travel) using onsite, at-home or drive-thru</li> </ol>
Holiday Testing Schedule	<ul> <li>Maintain testing cadence the weeks of Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year</li> <li>Use the At-Home kit (if on vacation or no onsite testing)</li> </ul>	<ol> <li>Test onsite on Wednesday as usual</li> <li>If on vacation, use At-Home kit (available from HR)</li> </ol>

^One exception to the 90-day no-test rule is if an employee becomes symptomatic prior to the end of the 90-day period (fever, chills, coughing, other respiratory issues, etc.) \*[November 16, 2020] Updated CDC guidance on exposed critical infrastructure workers requires them to be essential for the running of the operation before returning back onsite.
